 - Audio capability

Wimba Live Classroom Interface

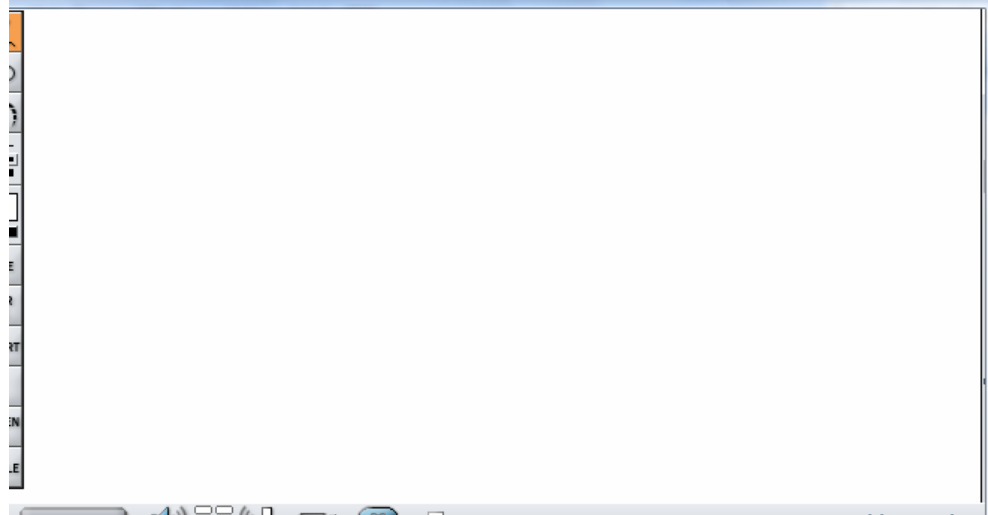

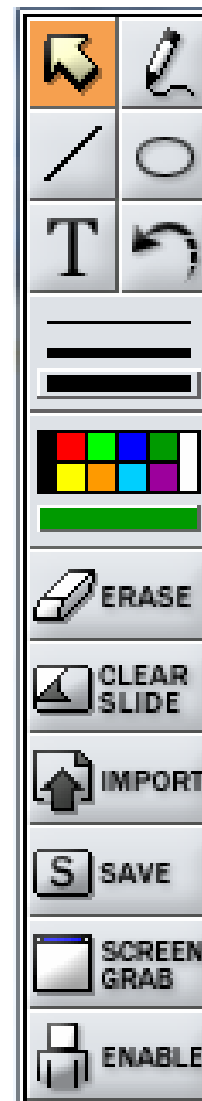
The Whiteboard or Content Area

The Media Bar



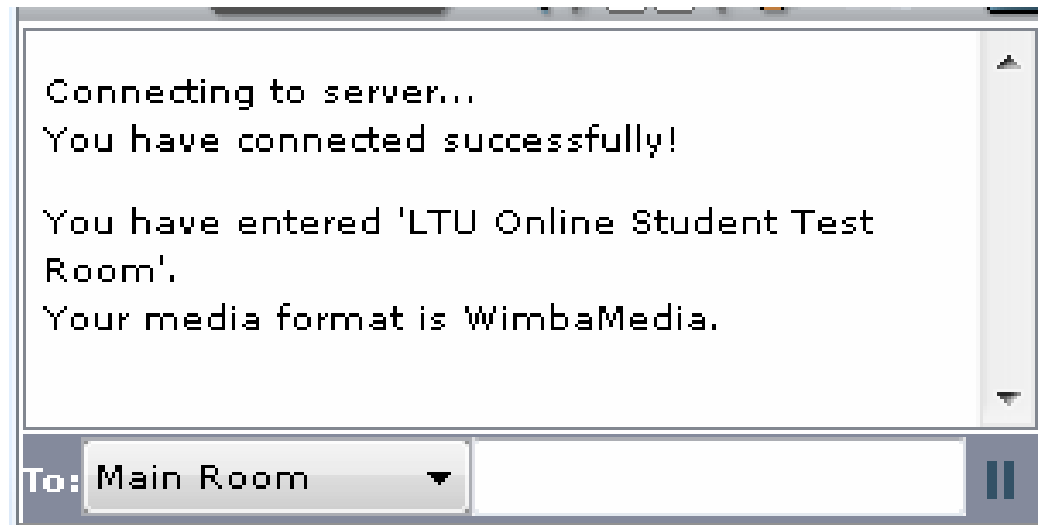
■ The Media Bar

- ❑ Shows your connection strength
- ❑ Allows you to click and hold to talk
- ❑ Allows you to adjust your speaker volume
- ❑ Allows you to adjust your microphone volume
- ❑ Allows you to enable your video
- ❑ Gives you dial in information
- ❑ Gives you access other media options

The Text Chat Area

■ The Text Chat Area

- ❑ Has an area for viewing text chats
- ❑ Has an area for typing in text chats
- ❑ Allows you to chat to the main room or to individuals
- ❑ May be paused
- ❑ May be scrolled



The Participant Area

- The Participant Area
 - Shows who is in the room and who is active
 - Shows their responses to polls
 - Allows participants to raise their hands
 - Allows participants to give various type of input
